- Dimensions should be 2 inches by 5 inches.
- Handmade bookmarks are welcome. Keep in mind the rubric below.
- They may also be designed on the computer and printed on cardstock.
- Your book mark should be colorful and descriptive of Paul's journeys.

Grading rubric:

Cities that Paul visited <u>in order</u> of his trips	50 points
Completing the Bible reading and returning the chart.	20 points
Creativity	10 points
Mechanics (spelling, capitalization, punctuation etc)	10 points
Neatness	5 points
On time	5 points
