JOB PURPOSE:

Chestertown Christian Academy is seeking an innovative and relational Technology Teacher who is responsible for teaching technology and computer science-related classes to elementary, middle, and high school students. The long-term goal of this position would be to develop a more comprehensive technology program for our students. Course content includes digital citizenship, keyboarding/computer skills, basic coding, and computer applications (i.e. Microsoft Office and Google Suite). A successful candidate will hold a degree in technology, education, another closely related field, or have hands-on experience applicable. Applicants should be prepared to articulate an active faith in Jesus Christ and demonstrate the ability to appropriately engage students of various age-levels and technological competencies.

Responsibilities:

- Demonstrate knowledge of subject area/s and developmental characteristics of age group(s) taught;
- Effectively utilize the basic elements of instruction and assessment techniques to inform and evaluate student learning and progress;
- Demonstrate ability to inspire learning and cultivate relationships with students;
- Prepare appropriate weekly lesson plans including instructional objectives, planned activities, Biblical integration, assessments, and resources;
- Provide a variety of learning materials and resources for use in educational activities to support proper differentiation of instruction;
- Implement effective classroom management and discipline procedures to provide for a positive classroom environment conducive to learning;
- Update all student and school records accurately and completely as required;
- Model effective teacher/parental partnering through timely and proactive communication with parents in support of student behavioral and academic success (posting of assignments, grades, conferencing, etc.); Assist with enlarging the vision and mission of Chestertown Christian

Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree in computer, technology, or a related field
- Teaching experience, preferably in a Christian school environment
- Strong commitment to integrating Christian principles into the classroom
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Ability to develop and implement engaging and effective lesson plans
- Positive and collaborative attitude
- Holds to a personal commitment to Jesus Christ and is active in a local evangelical church
- Is in complete agreement with and committed to the CCA's Statement of Faith
- Able to articulate a Biblical worldview as the foundation of strong Christian
